

Ehrhardt Eagle Student Afternoon Dismissal Procedure

To ensure the safety of all students at dismissal time,
please follow the procedure listed below.

Walker/Bike Riders –

Students that walk home from school will be dismissed from two doors.

Students walking/cycling to homes in **Spring Creek Forest** will be dismissed from the Kindergarten doors (See Map).

Students in Grades PK, K, 1, 3, 4 and 5 walking/cycling to **Oakwood Glen** will be dismissed from the cafeteria doors on the back side of the building (See Map). Students in Grade 2 walking/cycling to **Oakwood Glen** will be dismissed from the 2nd grade doors on the back side of the building (See Map).

*A student is a walker/bike rider **only if they are walking OFF school property**. Parents will not be able to park on school property or school roadways to meet walkers/bike riders. You may park off school property and walk up to meet your child at the designated walker/bike rider exit. To explain more clearly, the car rider dismissal procedure is established for all parents to come on campus with their cars to pick up their students.*

Car Rider Pick up –

Parents picking up students as car riders will enter the school property single file from **Seven Pines Drive** (See Map). Follow the single file car line to the car pick up zone stop sign. Cars will form **two** lines in the student pick up area (See Map). Students will be called from the cafeteria to the loading area based on your car rider number. Cars are to pull forward as far as possible to allow 16 cars in the loading area. **You will exit the loading area only after school staff have verified that all students in the loading group are loaded.** If your child does not meet you at the loading area after being called and cars are exiting, you will be guided to move to the **secondary loading area** in the parking lot near the gym for assistance (See Map). **Exit the loading area carefully as two lanes of cars merge to exit.**

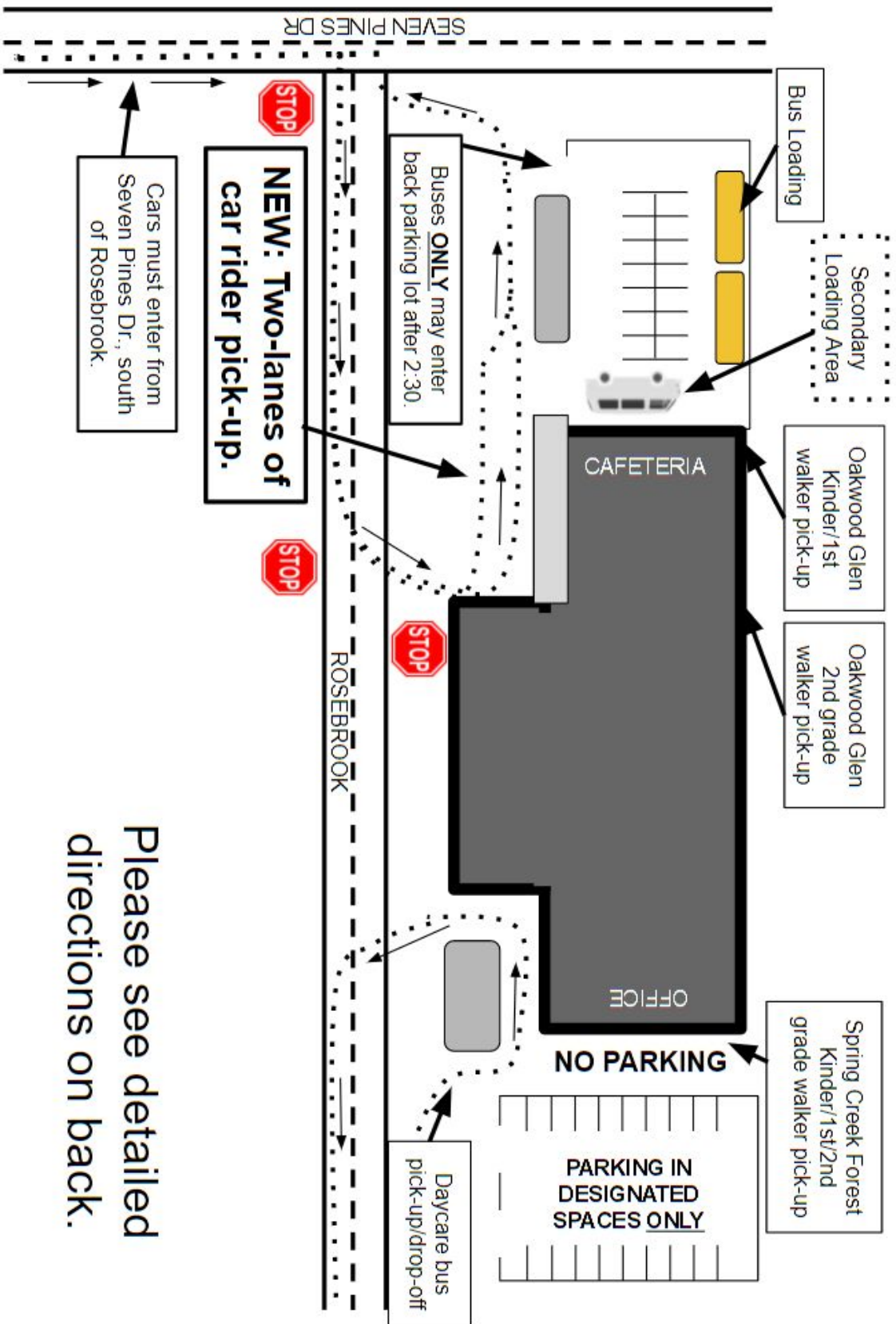
Bus Riders –

Bus riders will be provided a colored band to wear to indicate the bus they will ride. They will be escorted to the bus loading zone for boarding. Please make sure they wear their band the entire first week of school.

Day Care and non-Klein buses –

Day care and non-Klein buses will board in the driveways near the flagpole (Spring Creek Forest Side). **Cars are not to enter this area during dismissal.** Buses and vans require a larger turning radius.
